We stand as the choir and clergy enter the church.

We sit for the NOTICES.

We sit or kneel as we pray a prayer of PREPARATION for the service: Loving God, we have come to worship you. Help us to pray to you in faith, To sing your praise with gratitude, And to listen to your word with eagerness; Through Christ our Lord. Amen.

We have a time of **CONFESSION**, a time when we acknowledge our failings before God and ask and receive his forgiveness.

God shows his love for us in that, while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Let us then show our love for him by confessing our sins in penitence and faith.

Most merciful God, Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, we confess that we have sinned in thought, word and deed. We have not loved you with our whole heart. We have not loved our neighbours as ourselves. In your mercy, forgive what we have been, help us to amend what we are, and direct what we shall be; that we may do justly, love mercy, and walk humbly with you, our God. Amen. May the God of love and power forgive you and free you from your sins, heal and strengthen you by his Spirit, and raise you to new life in Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

We remain standing for our **GOSPEL READING** Hear the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to *N.* **Glory to you, O Lord.**

At the end of the reading: This is the Gospel of the Lord. **Praise to you, O Christ.** We sit to hear the SERMON.

We proclaim our faith in the words of the APOSTLES' CREED

Do you believe and trust in God the Father? I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth.

Do you believe and trust in his Son Jesus Christ? I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, Born of the Virgin Mary, Suffered under Pontius Pilate, Was crucified, died and was buried; He descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again; He ascended into heaven, He is seated at the right hand of the Father, And he will come to judge the living and the dead.

Do you believe and trust in the Holy Spirit? I believe in the Holy Spirit, The holy catholic Church, The communion of saints The forgiveness of sins, The resurrection of the body, And the life everlasting. Amen.

The Eucharist



We stand to share the PEACE.

We are the Body of Christ. In the one Spirit we

were all baptized into one body. Let us then pursue all that makes for peace and builds up our common life.

The peace of the Lord be always with you and also with you.

We share with one another a sign of peace, such as a handshake.

We remain standing to sing our **OFFERTORY HYMN**, during which a collection is taken for the work of the church, and the bread and wine are placed on the holy table.

We say together:

Yours, Lord, is the greatness, the power the glory, the splendour and the majesty; for everything in heaven and on earth is yours. All things come from you and of your own do we give you.

We remain standing for the EUCHARISTIC PRAYER The Lord is here His Spirit is with us Lift up your hearts We lift them to the Lord Let us give thanks to the Lord our God. It is right to give thanks and praise.

It is indeed right, It is our duty and our joy, At all times and in all places To give you thanks and praise, Holy Father, heavenly King, Almighty and eternal God, Through Jesus Christ your Son our Lord. And now we give you thanks For your blessing on this house of prayer, Where through your grace we offer you the sacrifice of praise And are built by your Spirit into a temple made without hands, Even the body of your Son Jesus Christ.

Therefore with angels and archangels, And with all the company of heaven, We proclaim your great and glorious name, For ever praising you and singing:

Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might, Heaven and earth are full, heaven and earth are full, Heaven and earth are full of your glory. Hosanna, Hosanna, Hosanna in the highest; Hosanna, Hosanna, Hosanna in the highest.

Who, in the same night that he was betrayed, Took bread and gave you thanks; He broke it and gave it to his disciples, saying: Take, eat; this is my body which is given for you; Do this in remembrance of me. In the same way, after supper He took the cup and gave you thanks; He gave it to them saying: Drink this, all of you; This is my blood of the new covenant, Which is shed for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins. Do this, as often as you drink it, In remembrance of me.

Therefore, heavenly Father, We remember his offering of himself Made once for all upon the cross; We proclaim his mighty resurrection and glorious ascension; We look for the coming of your kingdom, And with this bread and this cup We make the memorial of Christ your Son our Lord.
